Boston, MA (July 10, 2009) For decades, Travel + Leisure has been the gold standard publication for America's most savvy and sophisticated globe-trotters.

This year, Travel + Leisure readers were surveyed for the magazine's 14th annual World's Best Awards. Clio and Uni Sashimi Bar are operated by James Beard Award winner Ken Oringer (Best Chef Northeast 2001).

The Eliot Hotel is among a handful of small, independent hotels in Boston. In fact, in an era epitomized by chain hotels and corporate mergers, The Eliot has been owned by the same family since 1939.
